SAMPLE

Use this product to sequence the story "Stone Soup" ©. There are many versions of this story. I have chosen one that features a young man and an old woman. Copy the masters based on your needs (or enough to use to differentiate students). Students can sequence either with words or pictures, or they can match words to pictures and then sequence. Students should be able to sequence the story themselves and retell it after doing this activity. Great for large group, small group or as a center.

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SAMPLE

A young man came to town and he was hungry.

The old lady agreed and he asked for a pot.

"May I have a stone, please?" he asked you.

They filled the pot with water and put it on the fire. The man dropped the stone in.

In went the onions and the little old lady said, "Soup from a stone, fancy that."
